### INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE AND STRATEGY

The Fund aims to generate liquidity and stable income by investing in a diversified portfolio of primarily short-term fixed income instruments. The Fund aims to provide excess return over the return of the 91-day Philippine Treasury Bill, net of tax.

### **CLIENT SUITABILITY**

A client profiling process shall be performed prior to participating in the Fund to quide the prospective investor if the Fund is suited to his/her investment objectives and risk tolerance. Clients are advised to read the Declaration of Trust / Plan Rules of the Fund, which may be obtained from the Trustee, before deciding to invest.

The BPI Invest Short Term Fund is suitable only for investors who:

- Are at least classified as moderately conservative based on their risk profile
- Have an investment horizon of at least one (1) year

Risk:

The fund invests in short term domestic fixed income securities, exposing investors to the risk of loss arising from Interest Rate a rise in interest rates, which generally causes fixed income security prices to decline. Factors/events that may lead to a rise in interest rates include adverse market conditions, issuer-specific factors/events and/or negative developments in domestic political and economic conditions.

Liquidity Risk:

Investors are exposed to the risk of loss due to the Fund's inability to convert security holdings to cash immediately or in instances where conversion to cash is possible but at a highly disadvantageous price due to limited buyers/sellers in the market, low trading volumes or market disruptions, among other reasons/factors.



## **RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS**

The Fund has investments and trade transactions with Bank of the Philippine Islands, its subsidiaries and related parties:

Bank of the Philippine Islands - PHP 6.938 billion BPI Direct Banko, Inc. — PHP1.5 billion

Investments in the said outlets were approved by the BPI AMTC's Board of Directors. Likewise, all related party transactions are conducted on an arm's length and best execution basis and within established limits.

### **OUTLOOK AND STRATEGY**

**Market Review.** The BPI Money Market Index returned 0.30% in November, while benchmark short-term government yields rose 46 basis points (bps) on average. Average daily trading volume rose to PHP11.35 billion from October's PHP7.04 billion with trades mostly seen on the short end (3- to 6-month papers) of the curve.

The Bureau of the Treasury (BTr) held four Treasury Bill auctions in November. The yields across the three tenors (91-, 182-, and 364-day) rose following the 75-basis point hike by the Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas (BSP) this month. The last auction for the month saw the 91-day fully awarded at an average rate of 4.205%, while the 182-, and 364-day papers partially awarded at average rates of 4.920%, and 5.150%, respectively. Towards the end of the month, the BTr released the December auction schedule with two Treasury Bill auctions and three FXTN issuances (5-, 12-, and 20-year tenors).

In the local economic space, the 3Q GDP expanded faster than expected at 7.6% YoY, mainly driven by strong consumption growth as overall mobility increased and revenge travel spending soared despite the higher cost of living. The local inflation for the month of October rose by 7.7% year-on-year, its highest level in 14 years. Prices for food and fuel remained elevated amid weather disturbances and supply side pressures. Consequently, the BSP hiked rates by another 75 basis points during their policy meeting held mid-month. Central bank officials continued to reiterate that they remained prepared to raise rates as needed, given persistently high CPI levels, as well as central bank policytightening measures globally.

**Fund Performance**. The Fund returned 0.24% during the month, behind benchmark by 4 bps. Meanwhile, the Fund returned 0.97% YTD, lower than the benchmark by 44 bps.

**Fund Strategy.** The Fund favors the safety of Time Deposits. Expectations of rising rates moving forward may provide an opportunity for better yielding investment outlets.

### LIST OF PROSPECTIVE INVESTMENTS

The following are among the Fund's approved investment outlets, wherein the Trustee intends to invest depending on strategy, availability, or other market-driven circumstances:

- (a) Tradable fixed-income instruments issued or guaranteed by the Philippine government or the BSP; tradable fixed-income instruments issued by financial institutions or private corporations; exchange-listed securities; marketable instruments that are traded in an organized exchange; loans traded in an organized market; and, such other tradable investment outlets/ categories as the BSP may allow.
- (b) Tradable fixed-income securities issued, underwritten, or otherwise dealt by BPI and/or any of its subsidiaries, affiliates, their successors-in-interest or assignees, their directors, officers, stockholders, and related interest, and any of their trust and fund managed accounts, under such terms and conditions as the Trustee may deem to be in the best interest of the Fund.
- (c) Collective investment vehicles managed by reputable fund managers the investment objectives and policies of which are generally consistent with those of the Fund, subject to then existing BSP regulations.
- (d) Bank deposits and such other investments allowed under regulations issued by the BSP.

The Fund may invest in allowed Bangko Sentral Securities Facilities (BSP-SF) as one of its approved investment outlets. Pursuant to Section 601-Q of the Manual of Regulations for Non-Bank Financial Institutions, as amended, participations to UITFs with exposure to BSP-SF shall be limited to **Philippine individual and corporate residents only**.

Where it is deemed that the identified non-Philippine resident participants' investments violate applicable regulations, BPI AMTC shall immediately redeem the investment.
