- Have an investment horizon of at least one (1) year


KEY RISKS AND RISK MANAGEMENT

Interest Rate Risk:	The fund invests in short term domestic fixed income securities, exposing investors to the risk of loss arising from a rise in interest rates, which generally causes fixed income security prices to decline. RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS

The Fund has investments and trade transactions with Bank of the Philippine Islands, its subsidiaries and related parties:

Bank of the Philippine Islands - PHP 8.647 billion

Investments in the said outlets were approved by the BPI AMTC's Board of Directors. Likewise, all related party transactions are conducted on an arm's length and best execution basis and within established limits.

OUTLOOK AND STRATEGY

Market Review. The BPI Money Market Index returned 0.15% in April, despite benchmark short-term government yields rising by 2 basis points (bps) on average. Average daily trading volume rose to PHP14.92bn from March's PHP13.83bn with trades mostlyseen on the short-end (6-month to 1-year papers) and belly (5-year papers) of the curve.

The Bureau of the Treasury (BTr) held four Treasury Bill auctions in April. Demand for the short-end of the curve was still healthy as all tenors across all auctions were more than twice oversubscribed throughout the month. Preference for lower duration securities prevailed as average rates for the final auction were awarded at 1.140%, 1.558% and 1.901% for the 91-, 182- and 364-day papers, respectively. Towards month-end, the May auction schedule was released with four FXTN issuances (3-, 5-, 7-, and 10-year tenors) and four Treasury Bill auctions amounting to PHP200 billion.

March headline inflation rose to a 6-month high of 4.0% year-on-year, as food, utilities and transportation costs rose in line with global fuel prices as the Russian-Ukraine tensions persisted. The figure was at the higher end of the Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas' (BSP) target range of 2-4% for the year. The central bank had earlier warned that with fuel costs rising as a consequence of geopolitical tensions, Philippine inflation could breach the target before the end of the second quarter. The BSP shall continue to monitor emerging risks to the outlook for inflation and growth, and adjust policy settings as needed.

Fund Performance. The Fund returned 0.04% during the month, behind benchmark by 4 bps. Meanwhile, the YTD performance of the Fund reported a gain of 0.15%, underperforming the benchmark by 13 bps.

Fund Strategy. The Fund favors the safety of Time Deposits. Expectations of rising rates moving forward may provide an opportunity for better yielding investment outlets.

LIST OF PROSPECTIVE INVESTMENTS

The following are among the Fund's approved investment outlets, wherein the Trustee intends to invest depending on strategy, availability, or other market-driven circumstances:

- (a) Tradable fixed-income instruments issued or guaranteed by the Philippine government or the BSP; tradable fixed-income instruments issued by financial institutions or private corporations; exchange-listed securities; marketable instruments that are traded in an organized exchange; loans traded in an organized market; and, such other tradable investment outlets/ categories as the BSP may allow.
- (b) Tradable fixed-income securities issued, underwritten, or otherwise dealt by BPI and/or any of its subsidiaries, affiliates, their successors-in-interest or assignees, their directors, officers, stockholders, and related interest, and any of their trust and fund managed accounts, under such terms and conditions as the Trustee may deem to be in the best interest of the Fund.
- (c) Collective investment vehicles managed by reputable fund managers the investment objectives and policies of which are generally consistent with those of the Fund, subject to then existing BSP regulations.
- (d) Bank deposits and such other investments allowed under regulations issued by the BSP.

The Fund may invest in allowed Bangko Sentral Securities Facilities (BSP-SF) as one of its approved investment outlets. Pursuant to Section 601-Q of the Manual of Regulations for Non-Bank Financial Institutions, as amended, participations to UITFs with exposure to BSP-SF shall be limited to **Philippine individual and corporate residents only**.

Where it is deemed that the identified non-Philippine resident participants' investments violate applicable regulations, BPI AMTC shall immediately redeem the investment.
