OUTLOOK AND STRATEGY			

Key Contributions to Portfolio Outcome: The combination of persistent inflation concerns, and anticipation of a more aggressive Federal Reserve led to a challenging April for markets with negative returns across both equities and bonds. Key contributors to portfolio income this month were covered calls, high yield, and floating rate loans, while interest rate management positions, US equities, and covered calls were the largest detractors from total return. However, currency management positions, floating rate loans, and government bonds helped to limit the overall decline in returns.

Main Portfolio Changes: Despite recent market volatility and a selloff in equities, a more optimistic outlook prevails. This optimism is fueled by positive earnings reports that continue to demonstrate economic growth. As a result, the investment strategy remains unchanged. Additionally, the portfolio has seen a modest increase in high-quality floating-rate assets, building on adjustments made earlier in the year.

Positioning & Outlook: Global markets dipped in April due to inflation worries, strong growth data, and an increased likelihood of a higher-for-longer interest rate environment. In the Equities space, the S&P 500 saw a pull back after a 5-month run of consecutive positive returns, but rebounded from the April lows to start off May. In the Fixed Income space, the 10-year US Treasury rose from 4.2\$ at the end of March to 4.7% at the end of April and the 2-year US Treasury yield closed above 5%, resulting in the worst monthly returns for government bonds of 2024 thus far. High yield bonds held in relatively well given their lower duration profile but were not immune to downside either while floating rate assets like CLOs proved an effective diversifier and delivered modestly positive results.
