

## **OUTLOOK AND STRATEGY**

**Market Review.** Global equity markets rallied in November. Markets were boosted by a better-than-expected October inflation print, increasing expectations of a slower pace of policy tightening from global central banks. Sentiment further improved driven by the possibility of easing COVID restrictions in China and improvements in the US-China relations after President Xi and President Biden met at the G20 summit. Global central banks remained committed to fighting inflation as the Federal Reserve raised its interest rates by 75 basis points. Federal Reserve Chair Jerome Powell said that the policy rate might remain restrictive for longer than expected but also indicated that the central bank may move to smaller rate hikes soon. Emerging markets outperformed broader equity markets, driven by a rebound in Chinese equities on the back of optimism on the country's easing COVID policies. Within the technology sector, all sectors returned positive performance over the month led by semiconductors, content and infrastructure.

Fund Performance. The fund increased by 1.80% in November, lagging its benchmark by 32 basis points. Security selection within the software sub-sectors detracted from performance.

**Fund Strategy.** We view the current market environment as favoring quality and value, driven by expectations of higher interest rates, higher inflation, slowing economic growth, and geopolitical instability. The fund increased its exposure to stable and quality stocks, adding more defensive characteristics to the portfolio in the midst of a broader volatile market. The recent concerns over rising interest rates and higher inflation have put pressure on technology stocks but the companies within the portfolio continue to be underpinned by compelling fundamentals and powerful, long-term secular growth drivers. The secular growth trends driving technology are multi-year transformations that are expected to persist, regardless of the macroeconomic environment or geopolitical risk. The fund will continue to focus on these long-term secular themes such as artificial intelligence, cloud computing, electric vehicles, metaverse and quantum computing.

## LIST OF PROSPECTIVE INVESTMENTS

The following are among the Fund's approved investment outlets, wherein the Trustee intends to invest depending on strategy, availability, or other market-driven circumstances:

- (a) Primarily in a single collective investment scheme whose investment objective is to provide investment results in excess of the return of the MSCI AC World Information Technology Index; provided further that such CIS is approved or registered and supervised by a regulatory authority that is a member of the International Organization of Securities Commissions (IOSCO) and managed by reputable fund manager/s; provided further that the investment in the said collective investment scheme should at least be ninety percent (90%) of the total assets of the Fund. The Target Fund must be recognized as a collective investment scheme in its home jurisdiction by a regulatory authority or any regulatory authority acceptable to the BSP to supervise this CIS.
- (b) Short-term tradable fixed-income instruments issued or guaranteed by the Philippine government or the BSP; tradable securities issued by the government of a foreign country, any political subdivision/agency of a foreign country or any supranational entity; tradable fixed-income instruments issued by foreign or local financial institutions or private corporations; exchange- listed securities; marketable instruments that are traded in an organized exchange; loans traded in an organized market; and, such other tradable investments outlets/ categories as the BSP may allow. Provided, that, a financial instrument is regarded as tradable if two-way prices are quoted, readily available or regularly available from an exchange, dealer, broker, industry group, pricing service or regulatory agency, and those prices represent actual and regularly occurring market transactions on an arm's length basis.
- (c) Short-term tradable fixed-income instruments issued, underwritten, or otherwise dealt by BPI and/or any of its subsidiaries, affiliates, their successors-in-interest or assignees, their directors, officers, stockholders, and related interest, and any of their trust and fund managed accounts, under such terms and conditions as the Trustee may deem to be in the best interest of the Fund; and, any such other instruments as may be allowed under BSP regulations. Investment with related interests shall be in accordance with Section 414-Q of the Manual of Regulations for Non-Bank Financial Institutions.
- (d) The principal investments of the Fund will be denominated in, but not limited to the U.S. Dollar. The target fund invests in securities denominated in other currencies.
- (e) Bank deposits or tradable debt instruments issued by the BSP.
- (f) Such other investments allowed under regulations issued by the BSP.

#### INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE OF TARGET FUND

The BlackRock World Technology Fund seeks to maximize total return. The Fund invests globally at least 70% of its total assets in the equity securities of companies whose predominant economic activity is in the technology sector.
