INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE AND STRATEGY

The Fund intends to achieve for its participants investment returns that track the performance of the BPI Philippine Consumer Equity Index by investing in a diversified portfolio of stocks in the same weights as the index, to the extent practicable.

CLIENT SUITABILITY

A client profiling process shall be performed prior to participating in the Fund to guide the prospective investor if the Fund is suited to his/her investment objectives and risk tolerance. Clients are advised to read the Declaration of Trust / Plan Rules of the Fund, which may be obtained from the Trustee, before deciding to invest.

The BPI Invest Philippine Consumer Equity Index Fund is suitable only for investors who:

- Are classified as aggressive based on their risk profile
- Have an investment horizon of more than five(5) years.

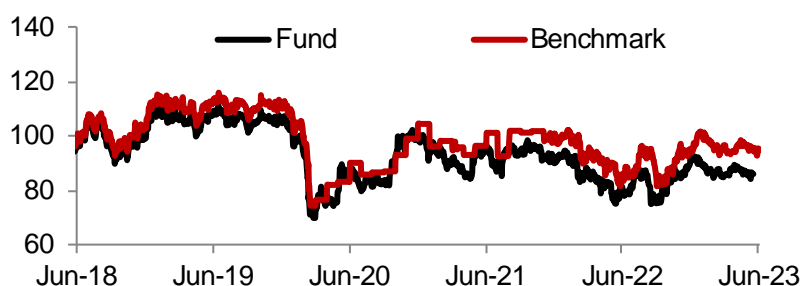

OUTLOOK AND STRATEGY

Market Review. Consumer stocks fell taking cue on the Department of Finance's (DOF) proposal to impose new taxes on "junk food" and expand the beverage tax.

Bottom three Consumer Index Constituents were:

- WLCON (-14.96%),
- JGS (-7.40%)
- PGOLD (-2.97%)

Fund Performance. The Fund returned -1.03% MoM, behind the Philippine Consumer Equity Index by 9 bps.

Fund Strategy. The fund will continue to track the Philippine Consumer Index.

LIST OF PROSPECTIVE INVESTMENTS

The following are among the Fund's approved investment outlets, wherein the Trustee intends to invest depending on strategy, availability, or other market-driven circumstances:

- Shares of stock of selected corporations which are already listed or being offered publicly and soon to be listed in the Philippine stock market.
- Primarily short-term tradable fixed-income instruments issued or guaranteed by the Philippine government or the BSP; exchange-listed securities; marketable instruments that are traded in an organized exchange; loans traded in an organized market; and such other tradable investment outlets/ categories as the BSP may allow. Provided, that, a financial instrument is regarded as tradable if two-way prices are quoted, readily available or regularly available from an exchange, dealer, broker, industry group, pricing service or regulatory agency, and those prices represent actual and regularly occurring market transactions on an arm's length basis.
- Primarily short-term tradable fixed-income instruments issued, underwritten, or otherwise dealt by BPI and/or any of its subsidiaries, affiliates, their successors-in-interest or assignees, their directors, officers, stockholders, and related interest, and any of their trust and fund managed accounts, under such terms and conditions as the Trustee may deem to be in the best interest of the Fund; and any such other instruments as may be allowed under BSP regulations. Investment with related interests shall be in accordance with Subsection X410.12 (a) of the Manual of Regulations for Banks.
- Bank deposits or tradable debt instruments issued by the BSP.
- Such other investments allowed under regulations issued by the BSP.

The Fund shall be primarily invested in a diversified portfolio of equities listed at the Philippine Stock Exchange. Portfolio composition and weightings will be the same as that of the BPI Philippine Consumer Equity Index
