INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE AND STRATEGY

The Fund, operating as a fund-of-funds, seeks to achieve for its Participants long-term capital growth by investing in a diversified portfolio of global equity collective investment schemes which integrate environmental, social, and governance criteria in its investment process, including the incorporation of sustainability goals and facilitation of flow of funds towards green economic activities, climate change mitigation and adaptation projects, and other positive environmental and social impact initiatives. The Fund aims to outperform its benchmark which is the MSCI AC World Index.

CLIENT SUITABILITY

A client profiling process shall be performed prior to participating in the Fund to guide the prospective investor if the Fund is suited to his/her investment objectives and risk tolerance. Clients are advised to read the Declaration of Trust/Plan Rules of the Fund, which may be obtained from the Trustee, before deciding to invest.

The BPI Invest Sustainable Global Equity Fund-of-Funds is for investors who:

- · Are at least classified as aggressive based on their risk profile.
- Have an investment horizon of at least five (5) years.

Participation in the Fund shall be open to Participants with legal capacity to contract and who are not considered US persons under the US securities and tax laws, subject to the other conditions, rules or provisions stated in the Plan Rules and those established by the Trustee. No beneficial owner shall hold more than 10% of the Fund. Any investor who owns more than 10% shall be asked to redeem the amount (or its equivalent number of units) in excess of 10% within thirty (30) calendar days.

Market/Price Risk:

Investors are exposed to adverse changes in the prices of global equity investments of the target funds due to adverse market conditions, unfavorable company earnings and valuations, and negative developments in the political and economic conditions of the focus countries of the target funds.

Investors are exposed to the risk of loss due to the inability of the target funds to convert security holdings to Liquidity Risk: cash immediately or in instances where conversion to cash is possible but at a highly disadvantageous price

OUTLOOK AND STRATEGY

Market Review. Global equity markets declined in August. US equities fell for the month amid expectations of another rate hike for the year on the back of US economic data and as rating agency Fitch downgraded the US' credit rating from the top-rated AAA to AA. In the annual Jackson Hole symposium, Federal Reserve Chair Jerome Powell reiterated the commitment to bringing inflation back to target. US inflation slightly increased at an annual rate of 3.2% in July from 3.0 % in June. In terms of business activity, the US economy slowed its expansion as its composite PMI declined from 52 to 50.4 month-on-month, driven by the further contraction in the manufacturing sector. Across other regional markets, Chinese and Hong Kong equities sold-off due to persistent uncertainties in the property sector and disappointing macroeconomic figures for China. The MSCI All Country World Index returned -2.76% for the month, with developed markets outperforming its emerging market counterparts.

Fund Performance. The fund returned -3.09% for the month, lagging the benchmark by 13 basis points. Security selection detracted from performance.

Fund Strategy. In 2023, we expect major structural trends such as the increasing market share of electric vehicles sold, increased recycled content in clothing and packaging, and record installations of wind turbines and solar panels to continue. The ongoing Russia-Ukraine war has resulted in the world, particularly Europe, determined to reduce their reliance on traditional sources of energy such as oil and gas, requiring large investments in renewable energy in the coming years. In addition, we continue to see support for climate solutions and green technologies through government policies such as the Inflation Reduction Act signed by US President Joe Biden. We believe that strong ESG companies are likely to generate positive financial performance over time as investing in sustainability can deliver higher growth and returns through innovation, higher operational efficiency and better risk management.

The Target Fund must be recognized collective investment scheme in its home jurisdiction by a regulatory authority or any regulatory authority acceptable to the BSP to supervise this CIS.

- (c) Money market instruments;
- (d) Short-term tradable fixed-income instruments issued, underwritten, or otherwise dealt by BPI and/or any of its subsidiaries, affiliates, their successors-in-interest or assignees, their directors, officers, stockholders, and related interest, and any of their trust and fund managed accounts, under such terms and conditions as the Trustee may deem to be in the best interest of the Fund; and, any such other instruments as may be allowed under BSP regulations.
